EV Bullen were contracted to carry out a complete site wide decommission, removal and certification of all Building Services in preparation of MOD Estate sale.

The works were carried out over a 12 month period encompassed surveying, logging and strip out of all services within approx 120 buildings. All external signage and sporting facilities were removed for disposal together with demolition of pre-fabricated buildings.

Specialist decommissions of fire arms ranges (opposite) with removal and certified disposal of recovered live ammunition.

The MOD requested Churchill's Bunker and adjoining buildings (opposite image) were retained for the public, necessitating re-configuration of sub main supplies and new switch rooms. The latter included historical switch gear and generators (specifically designed for operations in WW2) that have been restored, date and protection labelled for future generations.

EV Bullen have a long association with Heritage work and the project proved to be very interesting and absorbing for the project team.
